#### Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park Orienteering team Challenge

- Would you like to see how competitive your colleagues really are?
- Do you have it in you to be a medal winner!
- Can you think on your feet and multitask?
- Would you like to explore more of Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park and learn about this dynamic and exciting space?



We organise a competitive orienteering challenge in the Park where colleagues compete against each other teams to win points and claim the title of Orienteering Champion! Navigating an official British Orienteering Association Route team members must work together to map read, complete the course, and pick up bonus points along the way. There's something for everyone – this isn't just about sprinting the course, as bonus points can be earned through creative and fun photos, imaginative tweets and the careful delegation of tasks.

The Challenge takes about two hours, is based in the North Park, and ends with team photos and certificate presentations.

### Ride the Slide at the ArcelorMittal Orbit

You can descend the world's highest and, at 178m, the world's longest tunnel slide! As you travel down the UK's tallest public artwork, you'll pass through light and dark sections with London's dramatic skyline whizzing by! In the 40-second trip, you will circle around the ArcelorMittal Orbit 12 times as you weave your way through the famous loops and curves of the iconic structure, including a tight corkscrew section names the 'bettfeder' – after the German word for 'bedspring' – and end with a 50m straight run back down to earth!

The Park's cafes are located throughout the Park and can cater for your group's needs and budget year-round. If you're also looking to hire a space for more formal aspects of your day (presentations, meetings etc) we can support you find an option that works best for you.
